EXPLORING INNER AND OUTER REALMS

The summer Course in Norway offers an opportunity to experience nature in northern Europe and to meet people who seek a deeper relationship with Nature and therefore are willing to challenge themselves and to develop new capacities.

ABOUT THE PLACE

The School of Nature Summer Course will take place at an agricultural school on an ecologically managed farm located on a lake surrounded by forests and mountains in Fyresdal, a long valley in western Telemark.

ABOUT THE FACULTY

In the mornings there will be a seminar with **Ursula Flatters**, a physician at the Vidarklinik in Järna, Sweden, and with **Frode Barkved**, who is a teacher, eurythmist and general secretary of the Anthroposophical Society in Norway. In this seminar they will explore the possibilities and dangers of an inner path which can lead to the spirit in man and nature. This theme will be further developed through eurythmy by **Marianne Tvedt**, a teacher at the Stavanger Waldorf School in Norway. She will introduce the creative forces of language - vowels and consonants - as expressions of inner and outer realms. - Through excursions and through exercises in active observation, **Hans-Christian Zehnter**, a biologist and coworker at the Goetheanum in Dornach, Switzerland, will draw attention to the ways in which nature manifests. **Michael Seddon**, a gardener, will complement this by guiding participants toward an experience of the inherent mood of the

landscape. This experience will arise as participants engage in the cultivation of the landscape. - **Patrick Müllerschön** (Switzerland) and **Hannes Weigert** (Norway) are both painters and will lead a painting workshop which will focus on the question of how certain processes in nature and in the human soul can be visualised and experienced through colours. Through drawing they will also explore the landscape in the light of the northern summer nights.

PLEASE NOTE Evenings will be free.

The Summer Course will leave space for walks and conversations, artistic activity, swimming or garden work. - Families with children are warmly welcome! - Bring good walking shoes and rain gear! - The Summer Course will be mainly conducted in English.
